

Wellington hospital is a 400+ bed tertiary referral hospital servicing the Wellington region, the Hutt valley and other surrounding DHB's. The department is growing and presently has seven neurologists and four registrars. There are 2 dedicated neurology advanced training positions.

The department provides an active inpatient and outpatient service. Registrars spend time between neurology outpatients, providing acute neurology consultations and managing inpatients. There is an active stroke service with registrars assisting with acute stroke thrombolysis. We enjoy a good working relationship with the neurosurgical service.

Training registrars have dedicated time set aside for supervised EEG reading and supervised EMG clinics. There are weekly clinical audit meetings within the department as well as journal club and weekly registrar neurology and neurophysiology teaching. There is also a weekly departmental neuroradiology meeting.

Wellington itself is a vibrant city with numerous outdoor activities in and around the surrounding forests, parks and coastline or on the water. The city has an active social scene with numerous cafes, restaurants, theatres and music.

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
